**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF ADDITIONAL NOTICE
PLAN AND DUAL NOTICE**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Jeanne M. Cochran upon the Minnesota Public Employment Relations Board's (Board) request for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060, .2080 (2015) of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

Under its Additional Notice Plan, the Board plans to notify:

- 2,300 people or organizations involved in labor law in Minnesota including those who have signed up to receive rulemaking information from the Board;
- Public employees through notice to the following organizations: Education Minnesota; Minnesota Public Employees Association; American Federation of Labor and Congress of Industrial Organizations; American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees; Minnesota Association of Professional Employees; Middle Management Association; Minnesota School Employees Association; Minnesota Teamsters Public and Law Enforcement Employees Union Local No. 320; Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals; and Minnesota Elementary School Principals;
- Public employers through notice to the following entities and organizations: Association of Minnesota Counties; City of Minneapolis; City of St. Paul; League of Minnesota Cities; Metropolitan Council; Minnesota Public Employer Labor Relations Association; Minnesota Association of Townships; Minnesota Hospital Association; Minnesota School Board Association; Minnesota State Colleges and Universities Association; State of Minnesota; and University of Minnesota;
- State of Minnesota Bureau of Mediation Services; and
- Minnesota State Bar Labor and Employment Law Sections.

In addition, the Board will issue news releases to newspaper, radio, television, magazine and electronic news organizations with a link to the proposed rules. The Board will also post a copy of the notices and proposed rules on its website.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Board, and its plan to notify a wide-range of interested persons,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED**.
2. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED** contingent upon the addition of language in the Dual Notice stating that persons may request to be placed on the Board's mailing list to receive notice of future rule proceedings. See Minn. R. 1400.2080, Subp. 2(G).
