**ORDER ON REQUEST TO OMIT
FROM THE NOTICE THE TEXT OF
PROPOSED RULES, PURSUANT TO
MINN. STAT. § 14.22, SUBD. 1(B) (2014)**

This matter came before Chief Administrative Law Judge Tammy L. Pust on April 12, 2016. The Minnesota Gambling Control Board (Board) seeks an order authorizing the omission of the proposed rule text when it publishes the Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules Without a Public Hearing (Notice Plan). The Board asserts that publication of the proposed rules in the *State Register* is unduly cumbersome.

As an alternative to publication, the Board pledges that the Notice Plan will state that a free copy of the entire proposed rules will be available upon request to the Board and state how to make that request. The Notice Plan also will identify the website link where a copy may be obtained. Finally, the Notice Plan will state the subject matter of the omitted rules, cite the statutory authority for the proposed rules, and outline the proposed rules' purpose. In addition, the Board's Statement of Need and Reasonableness (SONAR) will be transmitted as outlined in the Notice Plan, which SONAR will be available free of charge by request and posted on the Board's website.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

Conditioned upon the Board's use of the procedures outlined in its petition of April 12, 2016, the petition to omit the proposed rule text is **GRANTED**.
