**ORDER ON REVIEW

On March 15, 2016, the Minnesota Department of Public Safety (Department) filed documents with the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) seeking review and approval of the above-entitled rules under Minn. Stat. § 14.389 (2014) and Minn. R. 1400.2410 (2015).
