ORDER ON REVIEW OF NOTICE PLAN UNDER MINN. STAT. § 14.3895

This matter came before Chief Administrative Law Judge Tammy L. Pust upon the request by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (Department) for a legal review of its proposed Notice Plan for giving notice of its plan to repeal Minn. R. 1562.0100, subp. 2 C; 1562.0300, and 1562.1700, subp. 6 pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.3895, subd. 2 (2018).

Upon review, the Chief Administrative Law Judge finds that the Department's Notice Plan is reasonably designed to notify persons and classes of person who may be significantly affected by the rules repeal by notifying organizations that represent those potentially affected.

Therefore, based upon a review of the written submissions and all of the documents in the rulemaking record,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The proposed Notice Plan is **APPROVED** with the condition that the organization listed as "Minnesota Soybean" is revised to "Minnesota Soybean Growers" and the organization listed as "Farmer's Union" is revised to "Minnesota Farmer's Union."
