
To join the online meeting (Now from mobile devices!):

1. Go to <https://intercall.webex.com/intercall/j.php?ED=222112632&UID=1577189372&RT=MIM3>



- *You may initially see a Preferences window. Click "No."*



- *If you get a login window, you do not need to enter user name or password. Just click on "Join as Participant"*




- If your computer does not have Java, you will be asked to install this plug-in. Click "Install Plug-in" and follow the prompts.



- Before you are allowed to join as a participant – if you have never participated in a webex meeting on this browser before - you may be prompted to download the webex local software (plugin) onto your browser. Click yes to download the software, and click "Run" to install it. You cannot participate in the webex without downloading the software. You could still, however, attend via phone conference.

2. You will then be connected to a Meeting Information Page. When the meeting has officially been started, the "Join" button will be activated and you can connect to the meeting. We will start the meeting at about 8:45 so that you can test your connection before 9:00 a.m.



Once you join the meeting you will also see a "teleconference" window pop up. We are not using this function of the webex, so just close that window and proceed. Teleconferencing information is provided below.
