

## **Possible Examples of “Program Participation”**

- 1) Participation in types of rates:
  - a) “Standard” rates (residential, business, C&I)
  - b) Time of Use rates
  - c) Green pricing (Windsorce, etc)
  - d) Electric Vehicle rates
  - e) Other (list)
  
- 2) Participation in a program related to generation:
  - a) SolarRewards (Xcel)
  - b) Net Metered customers
  - c) Community Solar Garden (once approved by the Commission)
  - d) Other (list, and list whether the utility would have data on the customers participating)
  
- 3) Participation in a program related to income:
  - a) Gas Affordability Programs (all rate-regulated gas utilities)
  - b) LIHEAP (Low Income Heating Energy Assistance Program) (all utilities)
  - c) Electric low income programs (MP, Xcel)
  - d) HeatShare (Salvation Army; unclear to what )
  - e) County emergency assistance (Counties; varies by county)
  - f) Weatherization programs (see also below)
  
- 4) Conservation Programs
  - a) CIP (Conservation Improvement Programs, all utilities)
  - b) Weatherization (Department of Commerce program)
  - c) Other (list, and list whether the utility would have data on which customers participated)

### **Homework:**

All participants should offer: 1) edits to the above list and; 2) be prepared to state which types of “program participation” they are interested in including in the definition.

Utilities should be prepared to state the number of customers generally enrolled in these programs, to begin discussions at a future meeting on understanding the risk of disclosing that data. Utilities should also be prepared to discuss or further research the amount of time and work that would be involved in responding to requests for the above data, to understand ratepayer impact at a later meeting.
