Subject: MISO Quarterly Update meeting

The Minnesota Public Utilities Commission has scheduled the MISO Utilities 2015 Second Quarterly Update Meeting for Friday, June 26, 2015 from 10:00 AM to Noon in the Commission's Large Hearing Room, Suite 350, 121 7th Place East, St. Paul, MN. The Commission invites participation from Minnesota electric transmission utilities and other interested persons on the following topics:

Summer Readiness

- Are Minnesota utilities ready to serve peak load reliably for summer 2015?
- Perspectives on expected 2015 summer energy prices compared to 2014 summer.
- What is the level of excess Installed Capacity (ICAP) for planning year 2015-2016?
- What is the level of load modifying resources (total and summer only) utilized to meet MISO's reserve requirement for the planning year 2015-2016?
- Are Minnesota utilities ready to serve peak load reliably for the summer of 2015 if MISO deployed load modifying resources for MISO footprint emergencies instead of Minnesota utilities' emergencies?

MISO-OMS Survey Result

- Are Minnesota utilities ready to serve peak load reliably for 2016 based on the MISO resource adequacy report?
- Do Minnesota utilities agree with the results of the MISO report?
- Do Minnesota utilities have any concern with the MISO-OMS survey process or result?

FERC Order 1000 Compliance

- What is the proposed cost allocation methodology for the Order 1000 interregional transmission projects?
- What particular interregional projects are being proposed or identified by MISO for the MISO-PJM seam and what financial impact, if any would these projects have on Minnesota utilities and their ratepayers?

- What particular interregional projects are identified for the MISO-SPP seam and what financial impact, if any, would these projects have on Minnesota utilities and their ratepayers?
