ORDER CLOSING DOCKETS

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On May 9, 1990, Kandiyohi Cooperative Electric Power Association and the Willmar Municipal Utilities Commission filed a joint petition for approval of an agreement modifying their assigned service area boundaries. In the Matter of the Joint Petition of Kandiyohi Cooperative Electric Power Association and the Willmar Municipal Utilities Commission for Approval of an Agreement on Service Territory Boundary Changes, Docket No. E-118, 329/SA-90-363. The Commission subsequently issued its ORDER

APPROVING AGREEMENT AND REQUIRING CHANGES IN SERVICE AREA MAPS, granting the petition.

The agreement was intended to end a series of boundary disputes between these two utilities and to prevent such disputes in the future. The parties agreed that open dockets on pending disputes, listed above, could be closed upon approval of the agreement. The Department of Public Service, which intervened in the matter, agreed.

The matter came before the Commission on July 24, 1990.

### FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

The dockets listed above involve boundary disputes which are governed and resolved by the agreement approved in In the Matter of the Joint Petition of Kandiyohi Cooperative Electric Power Association and the Willmar Municipal Utilities Commission for Approval of an Agreement on Service Territory Boundary Changes, Docket No. E-118, 329/SA-90-363. Since further action on these dockets is unnecessary, they will be closed.

### ORDER

1. The dockets listed on the heading of this Order have been resolved by the ORDER APPROVING AGREEMENT AND REQUIRING CHANGES IN SERVICE AREA MAPS in In the Matter of the Joint Petition of Kandiyohi Cooperative Electric Power Association and the Willmar Municipal Utilities Commission for Approval of an Agreement on Service Territory Boundary Changes, Docket No. E-118, 329/SA-90-363 and are hereby closed.
