ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR
RECONSIDERATION

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On November 10, 1992 the Commission issued its ORDER ESTABLISHING ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES AND REQUIRING FURTHER FILINGS in the above-entitled matter. That Order required changes in Minnegasco's cost allocations procedures and found that deficiencies in existing procedures did not rise to a level requiring structural separation of regulated and unregulated operations.

On November 30, 1992 the Minnesota Alliance for Fair Competition, the organization that had filed the complaint initiating the proceeding, filed a petition for amendment of the November 10 Order.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

Under Minn. Stat. § 216B.27, subd. 4 (1990), any application for rehearing not granted within 20 days of filing is deemed denied. The Commission believes adequate review of this petition will require more than 20 days. The Commission will therefore grant the petition for purposes of allowing careful review of the issues it raises. Deliberations on the merits of the petition will be scheduled at a later date.

ORDER

1. The Minnesota Alliance for Fair Competition's petition for amendment of the Commission's November 10, 1992 Order is granted for purposes of affording it careful review. An Order on the merits will follow that review.
2. This Order shall become effective immediately.
