ISSUE DATE: May 19, 1995

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PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On January 26, 1982, the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (the Commission) approved Lac Qui Parle County's final plan for the establishment of a 911 Emergency Telephone Services System.

On December 20, 1983, the Commission approved Farmers Mutual Telephone Company's (the Company) initial cost certification for the establishment of a 911 Emergency Telephone System in Lac Qui Parle County.

On March 1, 1994, the Company modified their 911 service to include Automatic Number Identification (ANI) and Local Location Identification (LLI) in the Cerro Gordo and Marietta Exchanges in Lac Qui Parle County.

On October 2, 1994, the Company certified the additional actual costs it incurred for the provision of 911 Emergency Telephone Service in Lac Qui Parle County.

Farmers Mutual is now requesting Commission approval of additional actual 911 system costs. This recertification is necessary for the monthly recurring 911 trunk charges. Commission approval is necessary before the Department of Administration (DOA) will make payments for 911 system costs.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

Minn. Stat. Section 403.11, subd. 3 states:

Subd. 3 (METHOD OF PAYMENT; CERTIFICATION.) A public utility incurring reimbursable costs under subdivision 1 or 2 shall certify those costs to the

commissioner of administration. The certification shall be in a form as prescribed by the commissioner after consultation with the public utilities commission. If the commissioner and the commission approve the certified costs as appropriate and accurate, the commissioner shall pay the certified costs from money appropriated for that purpose within 90 days following receipt by the commissioner of the certified costs. The commissioner of administration shall estimate the amount required to reimburse public utilities for the state's obligations under subdivisions 1 and 2 of this section and the governor shall include the estimated amount in the biennial budget request.

Farmers Mutual has certified, in writing, that the elements of 911 services and associated costs indicated on Attachment A reflect only charges for services actually rendered in the direct provision of 911 service in Lac Qui Parle County.

All other charges listed on Attachment A are in accordance with the Company's tariffs.

The Commission finds that the costs for 911 Emergency Telephone Service in Lac Qui Parle County which have been certified by the Company are appropriate and accurate.
