In the Matter of a Request for Approval by **Intelliphone, Inc. d/b/a AAA Pay Telephone Systems** to Limit the Duration of Local Calls from the Pay Phones Located in the St. Paul Town Square and World Trade Center

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

- 1. Approved the request to limit the duration of local pay phone calls, excluding 911 and 411 calls, to three minutes at the St. Paul Town Square and World Trade Center as a one year pilot program effective from date of Commission approval. Required posted notice on each pay phone of the calling limitations including notice that 911 and 411 calls are not limited.**
- 2. Directed Intelliphone to keep track of whether revenue is increasing or decreasing at the ten (10) phones and to survey the St. Paul Police, Viking Security, merchants and Koll Management to see if the pay phone associated problems decreased as a result of the time limitation and to report to the Commission the result at the conclusion of the program.**
- 3. Directed Intelliphone to program all pay phones in both the World Trade Center and St. Paul Town Square to block pager number dialing. Required posted notice on each pay phone of the**

pager restriction.

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Public Service which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
