In the Matter of a Request by Strategic Telecom Systems, Inc. for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Long Distance Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

- 1. Disapproved the request of Strategic Telecom Systems, Inc. for a certificate of authority to provide long distance services.**
- 2. Found that STS has provided long distance service in Minnesota in violation of Minnesota law. Referred the matter of STS' unauthorized sale of prepaid cards to the Office of the Attorney General for possible enforcement action.**
- 3. Found that STS has knowingly and intentionally violated Minnesota law by providing**

telecommunications services without authority.

4. Directed STS to, within 30 days of the date of the Commission Order in this case, either refund \$2,208.52 to Larry Schaefus Trucking, Ind. Or show cause why it should not be directed to do so.

5. Directed STS to, within 30 days of the date of the Commission's Order in this case, file a detailed report on the telecommunications services which it has provided in Minnesota.

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Public Service which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
