In the Matter of a Request by HBC Telecom, Inc. for Approval for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Facilities-Based and Resold Local, Private Line/Special Access and Long Distance Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Approved the application of HBC Telecom, Inc. for certification to provide statewide long distance service;

Approved the application of HBC Telecom, Inc. for certification to provide resold local exchange services in the following exchanges of Sprint Minnesota and US WEST Communications, Inc.: the City of Winona, the City of Rollingstone, the Village of Goodview, the Village of Minnesota City, the Township of Rollingstone, the Township of Homer and the Township of Wilson;

Approved HBC Telecom, Inc.'s long distance tariff with modifications received February 7,

2000;

Approved HBC Telecom, Inc.'s request for local and private line certification subject to the following conditions:

1 1. The certificate of authority to provide resold local exchange service is only for the above listed cities, villages and townships in the exchanges of Sprint Minnesota and US WEST Communications, Inc.;

2 2. The Company shall file for an amended certificate of authority and receive approval, pursuant to Minn. Stat. 237.16, subd. 4, before expanding its local service area;

3 3. The Company will be required to receive Commission approval of its interconnection agreements, 911 plan and proposed private line and local exchange tariff before it begins providing local exchange services in Minnesota.

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce and the Commission's Consumer Affairs Office which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
