ORDER APPROVING CERTIFIED 911 SYSTEM COSTS

BACKGROUND

On November 24, 1981, the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (the Commission) approved Houston County's final plan for the establishment of a 911 Emergency Telephone System.

On September 13, 1985, the Commission approved actual cost incurred by Spring Grove Cooperative Telephone Company for installing a portion of the Central Office Equipment needed to switch calls to the 911 Emergency Services System in Houston County.

On September 26, 1985, the Commission approved actual costs incurred by Northwestern Bell Telephone Company for installing a portion of the Central Office Equipment needed to switch calls to the 911 Emergency Services System in Houston County.

On January 29, 1986, the Commission approved actual costs incurred by Ace Telephone Association for installing a portion of the Central Office Equipment needed to switch calls to the 911 Emergency Services System in Houston County.

On August 22, 2000, the Commission approved actual costs incurred by Independent Emergency Services, Limited Liability Company for installing a portion of Automatic Number Identification (ANI) system in the 911 Emergency Services system in Houston County.

CURRENT FILING

On November 30, 1999, Houston County contracted with Kasson Mantorville Telephone Company (the Company) for E911 Emergency Telephone Services.

On February 1, 2000, the Company placed interexchange circuits to the Brownsville,

Caledonia, Caledonia Public Service Answering Point (PSAP), Eitzen, Hokak Houston, LaCrescent, and Spring Grove Exchanges as a portion of the installation for tandem based ANI service in the 911 Emergency Telephone Services System in Houston County.

On June 28, 2000, the Company certified the actual costs it incurred for the provision of ANI service.

The Company is now requesting Commission approval of the actual system costs for interexchange circuits for an ANI system. Commission approval is necessary before the Department of Administration (DOA) will make payments for 911 system costs.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

Minn. Stat. Section 403.11, subd. 3 states:

Subd. 3 (METHOD OF PAYMENT; CERTIFICATION.) A public utility incurring reimbursable costs under subdivision 1 or 2 shall certify those costs to the commissioner of administration. The certification shall be in a form as prescribed by the commissioner after consultation with the public utilities commission. If the commissioner and the commission approve the certified costs as appropriate and accurate, the commissioner shall pay the certified costs from money appropriated for that purpose within 90 days following receipt by the commissioner of the certified costs. The commissioner of administration shall estimate the amount required to reimburse public utilities for the state's obligations under subdivisions 1 and 2 of this section and the governor shall include the estimated amount in the biennial budget request.

Kasson Mantorville Telephone Company has certified, in writing, that the elements of 911 services and associated costs indicated on Attachment A, reflect only charges for services actually rendered in the direct provision of 911 service in Houston County.

All charges listed on Attachment A are in accordance with the Company's tariffs.

The Commission finds that the costs for 911 Emergency Telephone Service in Houston County which have been certified by the Company are appropriate and accurate.

3. This Order shall become effective immediately.
