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In the Matter of the Application of iLIKA Inc. d/b/a Microtech-tel for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Facilities Based and Resold Local and Interexchange Service

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

**Granted an operational certificate of authority to provide interexchange service on a statewide bases;**

**Granted a conditional certificate of authority to provide facilities based and resold local services in the exchanges currently being served by Qwest, Citizens Telecommunications of Minnesota, Frontier Communications of Minnesota and Sprint Minnesota;**

**The Company must file and receive Commission approval for an interconnection agreement and 911 plan;**

**Granted a waiver under Minn. Rules pt. 7829.3200 to the notification requirements in Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0200, subp. 6;**

**Approved the proposed tariff as filed on August 14, 2002 contingent upon the Company filing the following tariff revisions within 30 days of the date of this Order:**

**I. Add tariff pages covering call trace service in compliance with the requirements of Minn. Rules, Ch. 7813.**

**II. Introduce toll blocking and blocking of information service calls in compliance with the requirements of Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0600, subp. 1(E); and**

**III. Revise tariff page 34, section 2.6.3.L of the tariff to allow for notice before disconnection in cases of fraud in compliance with the requirements of Minn. Rule pt. 7810.1800 to 7810.2100 and Minn. Stat. § 237.73.**

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**This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).**

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
