In the Matter of the Application of BullsEye Telecom, Inc. for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Facilities Based and Resold Local and Long Distance Service

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Approved an operational certificate of authority to provide long distance service on a statewide basis;

Approved a conditional certificate of authority to provide facilities based and resold local service in the exchanges of Qwest Corporation, Sprint Minnesota, Citizens Telecommunications of Minnesota and Frontier Communications of Minnesota;

The Company must file and receive Commission approval of a 911 plan and interconnection agreement;

Approved a variance under Minn. Rules pt. 7829.3200 to the notification requirements of Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0200, subp. 6;

Approved the proposed tariff as filed on August 20, 2002.
