In the Matter of the Application of Houlton Enterprises, Inc. for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Long Distance and Facilities-Based Local Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Granted a conditional certificate of authority to provide facilities-based local services in the exchanges currently served by Qwest Corp., Frontier Communications, Citizens Telecommunications of Minnesota and Sprint Minnesota;

Granted a conditional certificate of authority to provide long distance service on a statewide basis;

The Company is required to file and receive Commission approval of a revised 911 plan which covers the provision of facilities-based local services, and file tariff pages for the proposed long distance services.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a

Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
