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In the Matter of the Application of Master Call Communications, Inc. for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Interexchange and Resold Local Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Granted an operational certificate of authority to provide interexchange services on a statewide basis contingent upon filing of a copy of the articles of incorporation within 30 days of the date of this Order;

Granted a conditional certificate of authority to provide resold local services in the exchange currently being served by Sprint Minnesota, Frontier Communications of Minnesota, Citizens Telecommunications of Minnesota and Qwest Corporation;

Conditions for approval:

Filing and receiving Commission approval of a 911 plan and interconnection agreement;

Within 30 days of the date of this Order, a copy of the articles of incorporation must be filed;

Before the Company begins providing local services, tariff pages must be filed that reference the local services required under Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0600, call trace services as required by Minn. Rules pt. 7813.0900, blocking of caller identification services and information services, and toll restriction service (as required by Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0600);

Granted a variance under Minn. Rules pt. 7829.3200 to the notification requirements in Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0200, subpt. 6;

Approved the proposed tariff as filed on June 30, 2003, noting the tariff requirements referenced in the Conditions section of this Order;

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
