In the Matter of a Request by Qwest Corporation for Waiver for Additional Numbering Resources

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Approved Qwest's petition;

NANPA shall fulfill Qwest's request for a block of 10,000 numbers in the Twin Cities rate center;

If the customer request is withdrawn, Qwest must "return the numbering resources to the NANPA, and may not retain the numbering resources to serve other customers without first meeting (NANPA's) growth numbering resource requirements";

Qwest shall inform the customer that excess numbers should be returned to Qwest, making them available for reassignment.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
