In the Matter of the Application of VCI Company d/b/a Vilaire Communications for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Local Exchange Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Approved the application for a conditional certificate of authority to provide facilities based local exchange services in the exchanges of Qwest;

Granted a variance under Minn. Rules pt. 7829.3200 to the notification requirements in Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0200, subpt. 6;

Approved the proposed tariff as filed on September 7, 2004, contingent upon (i) adding references to per call and per line blocking of caller identification services with no monthly charge as required by Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0600, subpt. 1I, (ii) adding references to blocking of information services with no monthly charge as required in Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0600, subpt. 1E, and (iii) eliminating the monthly charges for blocking of toll restriction service as required by Minn. Rules pt. 7812.0600, subpt. 1E;

Before the Company can begin providing long distance services, it must add long distance rates to its tariff;

Conditions to receive operational authority for local exchange services:

- 1. Commission approval of interconnection agreement**
- 2. Commission approval of 911 plan;**

The applicant may not provide local services until all conditions listed above have been fulfilled.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
