In the Matter of the Application of Telphonic for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Long Distance Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Approved the application for an operational certificate of authority to provide interexchange services on a statewide bases contingent upon filing, within 30 days of the date of this Order, documentation showing that the applicant has filed a "Certificate of Assumed Name" form with the Office of the Minnesota Secretary of State;

Approved the proposed tariff as filed on October 21, 2004 contingent upon filing, within 30 days of the date of this Order, the following tariff revisions:

1. Eliminate from the tariff references to call tracing service, the Link- Up Program, the Telephone Assistance Plan, and the Lifeline Program. These services are only provided in conjunction with local exchange services and do not belong in an interexchange tariff.

- 2. Change the reference to deposits on tariff page 2 to limit the maximum deposits to two months' actual or estimated bill as required by Minn. Rules pt. 7810.1600.**
- 3. Add reference to the toll free customer service number to the tariff.**
- 4. Add a reference to "Customer Complaints and Billing Disputes" to the tariff;**

The conditional certificate of authority will not become an operational certificate of authority until all of the conditions listed above have been fulfilled.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
