In the Matter of a Request by Frontier Communications, Inc. for Waiver of Pooling Growth Code Requirements in Pursuing Thousand-Blocks from Number Pooling Administrator

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Frontier has established a verifiable need for a thousand-block of numbers;

Petition granted;

NANPA shall fulfill Frontier's request for a thousand-block of consecutive numbers in the Apple Valley rate center in the 952 area code;

Frontier should request that any of the current numbers displaced by the thousand-block be returned by the customer for assignment to other customers;

If the customer request is withdrawn, Frontier must "return the numbering resources to NANPA, and may not retain the numbering resources to serve other customers without first

meeting (NAMPA's) growth numbering resource requirements."

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
