In the Matter of a Petition by Qwest Corporation Requesting Waiver for Additional Numbering Resources

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

**Qwest has established a verifiable need for six thousand-blocks of numbers;**

**Petition granted;**

**NANPA shall fulfill Qwest's request for six thousand-blocks of consecutive numbers in the Twin Cities rate center in the 651 area code;**

**If the customer request is withdrawn, Qwest must "return the numbering resources to NANPA, and may not retain the numbering resources to serve other customers without first meeting (NAMPA's) growth numbering resource requirements."**

**This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a**

**Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).**
