In the Matter of the Joint Application for Approval of the February 28, 2005 Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement Between VCI Company dba Vilaire Communications and Qwest Corporation (Originally Approved in Docket No. P-6400,421/IC-05-292); Changing or Adding Terms, Conditions and Rates for Certain UNEs

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Proposed amendment to interconnection agreement accepted, with the following conditions:

VCI Company dba Vilaire Communications received conditional local resale authority in Docket No. P-6400/NA-04-1496 on October 19, 2004. VCI Company dba Vilaire Communications shall not provide any type of telecommunication services in Minnesota under this interconnection agreement amendment until it has received an operational certificate of authority from the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission, which requires Commission approval of a 911 plan and the underlying interconnection agreement in Docket No. P-6400,421/IC-05-292;

VCI Company dba Vilaire Communications shall not assign the underlying interconnection

agreement as modified by this interconnection agreement amendment without Minnesota Public Utilities Commission approval.

The Commission notes and clarifies that the Department's comments inadvertently refer to VCI Company as VTI Company.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
