In the Matter of the Proposal of VCI Company dba Vilaire Communication to Change the Name on its Certificate of Authority to Vilaire Communication Company

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Approved, contingent upon the Companies filing, within 30 days of the date of this Order, the following tariff revisions:

a. The TAM surcharge in Tariff No. 2, page 30, section 3.4.6.5 should be changed from \$.05 to \$.07 (pursuant to the Commission's June 15, 2005 Order in Docket No. P-999/CI-05-624).

b. The TAP surcharge in Tariff No. 2, page 29, section 3.4.5 should be changed from \$.07 to \$.05.

c. Tariff language should be added in Tariff No. 2, page 32, section 4.4 to clarify that the "caller identification blocking activation fee" of \$10.00 may not be applied to business customers who have special needs for blocking services (such as law firms and medical offices), nor may the

proposed non-recurring charge be applied to any residential customer during the first 90 days after signing up for local service.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
