The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

All local exchange and interexchange carriers shall disconnect service arrangements enabling the identified carriers to provision intrastate telecommunications services to end use and

wholesale customers after submitting and receiving DOC approval of, a transition plan for any end-use or wholesale customers;

All local exchange and interexchange carriers with existing service arrangements for the provision of services to the identified carriers shall contact the Department in writing within 7 days of the date of this Order regarding the development of a transition plan for any end-use or wholesale customers, including the provision of notice;

All local exchange and interexchange carriers with existing service arrangements for the provision of services to the identified carriers shall formally discontinue and terminate arrangements enabling the identified carriers to provision intrastate telecommunications services to end use customers as of the effective date specified by the DOC in its future written notice approving transition plan;

All local exchange and interexchange carriers shall not engage in any new service arrangements for the provision of services that enable the identified revoked carriers to provide intrastate telecommunications service to end-use or wholesale customers effective immediately, unless this Order is suspended by another Commission Order.

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
