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In the Matter of the Relinquishment of Superior Technologies, Inc.'s Certificate of Authority

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Accepted relinquishment of Superior Technologies, Inc.'s certificate of authority;

Conditions of relinquishment:

Submission of a Telecommunications Carrier Annual Report for 2005 by May 1, 2006. Superior Technologies, Inc. will be potentially responsible for the true-up billing for the State's Fiscal Year 2006 Indirect Assessment Billing that will be mailed in the third quarter of the State's Fiscal Year 2007 or approximately January 2007 as provided by Minn. Stat. §237.295; however, companies with gross jurisdictional operating revenue of less than \$5,000 are exempt from assessments under this subdivision.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a

Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
