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In the Matter of the Application of YMax Communications Corp. for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Facilities-Based and Resold Local Exchange and Interexchange Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

**Approved the application for a conditional certificate of authority to provide facilities- based, resold local exchange service, and local niche service;**

**Approved the application for an operational certificate of authority to provide interexchange service;**

**Approved the request for a variance to Minn. Rules part 7812.0200, subp. 6, requiring an application to be served on all municipalities within the petitioner's designated service area;**

**Conditions to receive operational authority for facilities-based and resold local exchange services:**

- 1. Commission approval of 911 plan.**

**2. Commission approval of interconnection agreement.**

**3. Filing of the following tariff revisions: revision of TAP and TAM language to conform with templates in certificate of authority application; addition of blocking capabilities as required by Minn. Rule part 7812.0600, subp. 1(E) and subp. 1(I). Applicant may also choose to change deposit interest rate in accordance with template in certificate of authority application.**

**4. Operational local niche authority conditioned only upon filing of niche service in tariffs.**

**The applicant may not provide local service until the conditions listed above have been fulfilled.**

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**This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).**

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
