In the Matter of the Joint Application for Approval of the Interconnection Agreement Between Christensen Communications Company and Sprint Minnesota, Inc.

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Proposed interconnection agreement approved;

Sprint Minnesota, Inc. shall not provide any service under this Interconnection Agreement until Sprint Minnesota, Inc. receives written documentation that shows that CLEC has received unconditional authority from the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission to provide local service. This includes the transfer or porting of any local resale customers to the CLEC;

CLEC shall not assign the underlying agreement as modified by the amendment without the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission approval.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a

Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
