In the Matter of the Application of Charter Fiberlink, LLC for an Amended Certificate of Authority to Provide Facilities-Based Local, Resold Local, Interexchange, and Local Niche Services in Additional Exchanges

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Granted approval to Charter to expand its service area to offer facilities-based and resold local service, interexchange, and local niche service in the exchanges listed on Page 4 of the Department of Commerce comments;

Prior to serving customers in the newly expanded service area, Charter must take the following actions:

File an amended tariff, reflecting its expanded service area.

File and receive Commission approval of interconnection agreements with Embarq, Citizens, Frontier and Mankato.

File and receive Commission approval of its 911 plans for the newly expanded service area.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
