In the Matter of an Application of Unity Business Networks, LLC for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Facilities-Based and Resold Local Exchange Services, and Local Niche Service

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Conditional approval of the application to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange services; Operational approval of the application to provide interexchange services; Approval of variance.

Conditions to receive operational authority for local exchange service:

- 1. Commission approval of 911 plan for each area served;**
- 2. Commission approval of interconnection agreement with Qwest;**
- 3. TAM surcharge on page 57 should be updated;**
- 4. Pages 44-45, 58-59, 60-61 and 63 should be revised to reflect that the application does not provide residential service.**

Conditions to receive operational authority for local niche service:

1. Filing of local niche tariff.

The applicant may not provide local services until conditions listed above for local exchange service have been fulfilled.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (b).

The Commission agrees with and adopts the recommendations of the Department of Commerce which are attached and hereby incorporated in the Order.
