ORDER DENYING RECONSIDERATION

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On February 6, 2007, the Commission issued its Order Determining Compliance Issues in this case.

On February 26, 2007, the City of Buffalo filed a petition for reconsideration. On March 8, 2007, Wright-Hennepin Cooperative Electric Association filed an answer to the petition, urging its denial.

On April 19, 2007, the petition came before the Commission.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

The Commission has reviewed the record and heard the arguments of the parties.

The Commission finds that the City's petition does not raise new issues, does not point to new and relevant evidence, does not expose errors or ambiguities in the February 6 Order, and does not otherwise persuade the Commission that it should rethink the decisions set forth therein. The Commission concludes that those decisions are consistent with the facts, the law, and the public interest, and will therefore deny the petition for reconsideration.

The Commission will so order.

ORDER

1. The City of Buffalo's petition for reconsideration is hereby denied.

2. This Order shall become effective immediately.
