In the Matter of the Application of U-reka Broadband Ventures, LLC d/b/a Minnesota Fiber Exchange for a Certificate of Authority to Provide Local Niche Services

The above entitled matter has been considered by the Commission and the following disposition made:

Approved the application to provide interexchange services on a statewide basis.

Approved the application for an operational certificate of authority to provide local niche services in those exchanges of the following companies which are located in the 612, 651, 763, and 952 NPAs (i.e., numbering plan areas). Qwest, Frontier Communications of Minnesota, Citizens Telecommunications of Minnesota, Embarq Minnesota, Sherburne County Rural Telephone Company, Bridgewater Telephone Company, Lakedale Telephone Company, Eckles, Scott-Rice, Lonsdale, Winsted and Sleepy Eye Telephone companies.

Approved the proposed local niche tariff as filed on April 30, 2007 and revised on July 30, 2007 and August 14, 2007.

This decision is issued by the Commission's consent calendar subcommittee, under a delegation of authority granted under Minn. Stat. § 216A.03, subd. 8 (a). Unless a party, a participant, or a Commissioner files an objection to this decision within ten days of receiving it, it will become the Order of the full Commission under Minn.
