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##### **Contract Release T-796(5) Traffic Counters, Software and Accessories: Contract Ended Abruptly**

The State's contract with Diamond Traffic Products (DTP), State Contract 244144, Contract Release T-796(5), ended February 28, 2026. The contract ending is due to DTP's announced company closure, which the company communicated was effective February 27, 2026. DTP's roadside equipment gathers data about number and speed of vehicles. MnDOT and CPV customers analyze this data using DTP's Centurion software to study traffic flow patterns.

DTP has indicated that support for their Centurion software affiliated with their products will continue through the end of calendar year 2026. OSP and MnDOT are working with DTP to explore the possibility of other options available in the marketplace to support DTP's products.

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### **2026 Flood Emergency Resources**

Every spring the National Weather Service (NWS) prepares a series of flood outlooks for the potential of river flooding caused by snowpack melt. These outlooks contain information about the potential for flooding throughout the spring months. The information can help decision makers and those with river interests prepare. The 2026 forecast looks to be similar to this time last year. The Weather Service states in its 2026 Spring Flood and Water Resources Outlook that the overall risk for flooding this spring is around normal, and precipitation and rate of snowmelt through spring while the ground is still frozen will be one of the most important flood risk factors along the mainstem of the Mississippi River and its associated tributaries across southeast Minnesota, northeast Iowa, and southwest Wisconsin.

The Office of State Procurement has many [contracts](#) currently in effect that could be a source of materials, equipment, and services to assist governmental entities in a time of flood and for general emergency response. These contracts provide eligible Cooperative Purchasing Venture members and state agencies with the ability to order the goods and services needed without having to solicit them as the state contracts have already been solicited. State agencies can order in any dollar amount unless further restricted by the Contract Release or their agency without being limited by their individual delegation of authority. 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### **Contract Release C-1046(5) Computers: Desktops, Laptops, Tablets, Monitors, Printers, Accessories, and Services – New Contract Awards!**

On March 1, 2026, there were five new contract awards available for use. These include incumbents, new and TG/ED/VO Contractors. Please continue to reference the Contract Release before requesting quotes, as additional Contractors are likely to be added.

### **Price Sensitivity: Laptops, Desktops, Monitors and Tablets**

Supply and cost pressures are building across PC components (e.g. memory, storage, graphics processing units). As a result, PC hardware prices are increasing and may continue to increase throughout 2027. Entities are encouraged to contact the Contractors to discuss the projected increases, device options least impacted, and/or alternative solutions available that provide savings. Please note that increased demand may impact device availability and lead times in addition to cost.

### Sales and Use Tax Updates

The Minnesota Department of Revenue will be administering the following new sales and use taxes effective April 1, 2026:

#### [Faribault County 0.5% Transit Sales and Use Tax](#)

The Minnesota Department of Revenue will be ending the following sales and use taxes ending March 31, 2026:

#### [Scanlon 0.5% Sales and Use Tax ends March 31, 2026](#)

The sales and use tax rate changes apply to sales made on or after April 1, 2026. They will be in addition to all other taxes in effect. Local sales tax applies to retail sales made and taxable services provided within the local taxing area (county/city limits). The tax applies to the same items that are taxable under Minnesota sales and use tax law.

Agencies entering purchase orders for the new fiscal year, prior to January 1, 2026, tax effective date, will have the old rate calculated and will need to update their purchase orders.

Purchase orders entered in SWIFT on or after April 1, 2026, will calculate the new tax rates for each county/city. Existing purchase orders and/or their vouchers will need to be adjusted to pay the correct tax if delivery occurs after various dates. Please note that the dates will be different based on whether goods or construction materials are being delivered. Check the tax notice for the affected city for the correct dates.

### Impact of New Local Tax

See the Minnesota Department of Revenue tax notice for the appropriate city for guidance in handling purchase orders and payments during the transition period.

**Impact on Accounts Payable:** Vouchers entered in SWIFT on or after the tax effective date will calculate the new tax rates for each county/city if the Invoice Date is on or after the tax effective date. If the Invoice Date is before the tax effective date, SWIFT will exclude the new tax rates. Please review the tax calculation carefully prior to payment on all vouchers with Ship To locations within these jurisdictions.

**Impact on Purchase Orders:** SWIFT will be updated with the new tax codes for all existing Ship To addresses located in the affected cities. New purchase orders, created on or after April 1, 2026, will calculate the new rate of tax for the ship to addresses within those counties/cities. Existing purchase orders may or may not need to have the tax code updated on the PO if payment can be processed during any allowed grace period(s), again, see the general notice for each county/city. Previously any Ship To addresses in affected cities may have used the tax code of 0000, State Tax only.

To calculate the new combined rate, state and local tax rate, the tax code(s) on the purchase order must be updated to the new tax code(s) from the 0000 tax code. Because of the various transition rules, these codes will not be updated by SWIFT and must be updated by the purchase order buyer.

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**Monthly SWIFT Reminder: Late Payments on Purchasing Card Statements**

US Bank charges late fees on past due purchasing card (PCard) accounts. Agencies are invoiced in the amount of up to one percent (1%) per month on the amount overdue, or a minimum of \$2. Late fees are included on your monthly statement from US Bank and available to view in SWIFT. However, the Late Payment transaction cannot be reconciled the same way other transactions are reconciled.

To pay a late fee associated with a PCard statement, agencies must manually add this fee to their monthly PCard voucher by adding a line and entering the information. Make sure to enter Late Payment Charge in the **Description** field. In the **Account** field use Expense code 430008 (Interest Pd To Vend Late Pymt). After the line has been added, provide the voucher number to [SWIFT Help Desk](#) to have the transaction remove from the PCard pages.

As a reminder, pay PCard statements on time to avoid potential late fees, take advantage of available rebates, and avoid potential violations of Minn. Stat. §16A. Purchasing Policy 1b requires that Purchasing Card Coordinators use Access Online to review statements and monitor account activity.
