Important Reminder - Contract Release C-1046(5) Computers: Desktops, Laptops, Tablets, Monitors, Printers, Accessories, and Services – New Contract Awards

On March 1, 2026, there were five new contract awards available for use. These include incumbents, new and TG/ED/VO Contractors. Please continue to reference the Contract Release before requesting quotes, as additional Contractors are likely to be added.

Price Sensitivity: Laptops, Desktops, Monitors and Tablets

Supply and cost pressures are building across PC components (e.g. memory, storage, graphics processing units). As a result, PC hardware prices are increasing and may continue to increase throughout 2027. Entities are encouraged to contact the Contractors to discuss the projected increases, device options least impacted, and/or alternative solutions available that provide savings. Please note that increased demand may impact device availability and lead times in addition to cost.

Contract Updates: Contract Release D-233(5) Drivers or Motor Vehicle License Record Checks

The State is currently working on an amendment to extend the iiX contract for Motor Vehicle Record Checks, SWIFT Contract No. 192806, under Contract Release D-233(5). The contract with iiX will be extended through June 30, 2026. In addition, the State is finalizing a contract award from a recent solicitation with the intent that the new contract will be effective before June 30, 2026. The new contract will be available to all State agencies and CPV members.

Reminder - Sales and Use Tax Updates

The Minnesota Department of Revenue will be administering the following new sales and use taxes effective April 1, 2026:

[Faribault County 0.5% Transit Sales and Use Tax](#)

The Minnesota Department of Revenue will be ending the following sales and use taxes ending March 31, 2026:

[Scanlon 0.5% Sales and Use Tax ends March 31, 2026](#)

The sales and use tax rate changes apply to sales made on or after April 1, 2026. They will be in addition to all other taxes in effect. Local sales tax applies to retail sales made and taxable services provided within the local taxing area (county/city limits). The tax applies to the same items that are taxable under Minnesota sales and use tax law.

Agencies entering purchase orders for the new fiscal year, prior to January 1, 2026, tax effective date, will have the old rate calculated and will need to update their purchase orders.

Purchase orders entered in SWIFT on or after April 1, 2026, will calculate the new tax rates for each county/city. Existing purchase orders and/or their vouchers will need to be adjusted to pay the correct tax if delivery occurs after various dates. Please note that the dates will be different based on whether goods or construction materials are being delivered. Check the tax notice for the affected city for the correct dates.

Impact of New Local Tax

See the Minnesota Department of Revenue tax notice for the appropriate city for guidance in handling purchase orders and payments during the transition period.

Impact on Accounts Payable: Vouchers entered in SWIFT on or after the tax effective date will calculate the new tax rates for each county/city if the Invoice Date is on or after the tax effective date. If the Invoice Date is before the tax effective date, SWIFT will exclude the new tax rates. Please review the tax calculation carefully prior to payment on all vouchers with Ship To locations within these jurisdictions.

Impact on Purchase Orders: SWIFT will be updated with the new tax codes for all existing Ship To addresses located in the affected cities. New purchase orders, created on or after April 1, 2026, will calculate the new rate of tax for the ship to addresses within those counties/cities. Existing purchase orders may or may not need to have the tax code updated on the PO if payment can be processed during any allowed grace period(s), again, see the general notice for each county/city. Previously any Ship To addresses in affected cities may have used the tax code of 0000, State Tax only.

To calculate the new combined rate, state and local tax rate, the tax code(s) on the purchase order must be updated to the new tax code(s) from the 0000 tax code. Because of the various transition rules, these codes will not be updated by SWIFT and must be updated by the purchase order buyer.

Monthly SWIFT Reminder: Late Payments on Purchasing Card Statements

US Bank charges late fees on past due purchasing card (PCard) accounts. Agencies are invoiced in the amount of up to one percent (1%) per month on the amount overdue, or a minimum of \$2. Late fees are included on your monthly statement from US Bank and available to view in SWIFT. However, the Late Payment transaction cannot be reconciled the same way other transactions are reconciled.

To pay a late fee associated with a PCard statement, agencies must manually add this fee to their monthly PCard voucher by adding a line and entering the information. Make sure to enter Late Payment Charge in the **Description** field. In the **Account** field use Expense code 430008 (Interest Pd To Vend Late Pymt). After the line has been added, provide the voucher number to [SWIFT Help Desk](#) to have the transaction remove from the PCard pages.

SWIFT (Good To Know): Negative Encumbrances on Purchase Order Lines

Purchase order lines with negative encumbrance balances create unauthorized spending authority in appropriations. This unauthorized spending authority can lead to appropriations being over-obligated or over-expended once the budgets are closed. Please make every effort to close any unneeded negative encumbrances.

You can search for negative encumbrances using the **M_PO_GBL_NEG_ENCUMB_KK** query from the SWIFT Query Viewer. MMB’s Accounting Services recommends that buyers and budget staff review this query frequently and remedy negative encumbrances as needed, especially as the end of the budget year approaches.

Negative encumbrances generally fall into three categories:

- The purchase order line was originally established as a positive encumbrance but now has a negative encumbrance balance.
 - The purchase order currently has a negative encumbrance balance and has a "Valid" Budget Check status. If the encumbrance is in the current budget period, increase or close these lines immediately to eliminate the negative encumbrance.
- The purchase order line is closed, but the negative encumbrance balance remains.
 - The purchase order has a negative encumbrance remaining and has an "Error" Budget Check status. Make sure to verify that there are funds in the budget to close this type of

negative encumbrance. If the encumbrance is in the current year, agencies may need to adjust budgets for the budget check to succeed. If the encumbrance is in a closed budget period, please contact the [SWIFT Help Desk](#).

- The agency created a valid negative purchase order line.
 - Agencies may have intentionally entered the purchase order line as a negative value. Please review and verify that these lines are still needed. Also make sure that there is an offsetting positive encumbrance on the same purchase order. If there is not an offsetting encumbrance, the appropriation budget may be over-obligated upon budget close at fiscal year-end.
