Reminder: New State of Minnesota Master Contract Solicitation – Heavy Equipment Repair

The State of Minnesota is currently soliciting a new heavy equipment repair master contract. The Event# G0210-2000017548 was posted on April 21, 2026 and will run until June 30, 2026. This is an exciting opportunity for heavy equipment repair facilities around the state to provide repair services on the State of Minnesota and Cooperative Purchasing Member heavy equipment. Everything from bulldozers to medium duty size work trucks need repairs and the State is requesting responders for the event. If you know a business in your area that is interested in doing this work, let them know of the event and encourage them to respond.

Update: Contract Release D-233(5) Drivers or Motor Vehicle License Record Checks

The contract with iiX for Motor Vehicle Record Checks, SWIFT Contract No. 192806, under Contract Release D-233(5), was extended through June 30, 2026. The State does not anticipate any further extensions of Contract 192806.

The State also entered into a new contract with Kentech for Motor Vehicle Record Checks, under the same Contract Release. The contract with Kentech, SWIFT Contract No. 289544, is effective now through April 30, 2028. Both contracts are available to all State agencies and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) members (“ordering entities”).

Interested ordering entities should review the updated contract release posted on OSP’s website for additional details about both contracts. Reminder: Contract Release G-183(5): Gases – Specialty, Industrial, and EPA Protocol Gas Mixtures

Contracts were awarded to AirGas USA, LLC and Oxygen Service Company on 9/1/2025. Please be aware agencies have reached out after receiving Airgas USA, LLC invoices due to the inclusion monthly tank rental/demurrage fees. Airgas USA, LLC currently assesses a monthly rental/demurrage charge for certain tanks.

Ordering entities should review Airgas USA, LLC price schedule and contract documents to determine applicability of these fees. Agency buyers should continue to review both G-183(5) contracts for AirGas USA, LLC and Oxygen Service Company to confirm current pricing and applicable fees.

Monthly SWIFT Reminder: Late Payments on Purchasing Card Statements

US Bank charges late fees on past due purchasing card (PCard) accounts. Agencies are invoiced in the amount of up to one percent (1%) per month on the amount overdue, or a minimum of \$2. Late fees are included on your monthly statement from US Bank and available to view in SWIFT. However, the Late Payment transaction cannot be reconciled the same way other transactions are reconciled.

To pay a late fee associated with a PCard statement, agencies must manually add this fee to their monthly PCard voucher by adding a line and entering the information. Make sure to enter Late Payment Charge in the **Description** field. In the **Account** field use Expense code 430008 (Interest Pd To Vend Late Pymt). After the line has been added, provide the voucher number to [SWIFT Help Desk](#) to have the transaction remove from the PCard pages.
