Contract Release C-1005(5) Multifunction Devices Contracts - Re-Solicitation

State contracts under release C-1005(5), for Multi-Function Devices (MFD) Equipment Rental, Purchase and Maintenance will reach expiration August 31, 2026. The State intends to offer short-term extensions to contractors to prevent gaps in service. Preparations are underway to re-solicit these contracts.

\Expired MFD contracts are kept open for State and CPV customers to renew MFD leases and service & maintenance plans. MFD leases or service agreements lasts for its full executed term even if the overall OSP contract expires before the lease or service agreement does.

The contracts are solely with MFD **manufacturers**. Current manufacturers on C-1005(5) include Canon, Kyocera, Ricoh and Toshiba. Previously, Xerox and HP have held contracts.

Canon, Kyocera, and Ricoh use **authorized resellers** to provide service and sales through their OSP contracts. Toshiba does not. The C-1005(5) contract release document contains links for resellers if the manufacturer uses them. No MFD reseller is directly awarded a contract under C-1005(5). While the State considers the resellers to be extensions of the manufacturer, the contract itself is with the manufacturer, not with the reseller. Resellers must meet all of the same terms, conditions, and prices as manufacturers. If a reseller does not meet the contract terms in any way, that concern can be raised to OSP, the reseller, and to the manufacturer.

Contract Release M-562(5): Furnish, Installation, Operation, and Maintenance of Water Treatment Systems for Residential and Small Commercial, or Noncommunity Public Water Supply Wells for State Agencies and Cooperative Purchase Venture (CPV) Members

Contracts recently awarded to: Culligan Water of Greater Rochester (Certified Veteran-Owned Contractor), Commers Conditioned Water Company, Culligan of Stillwater, Culligan Ultrapure Inc., Culligan Water Baxter, Culligan Water Buffalo, Culligan Water Minnetonka, Culligan Water Ramsey, Culligan Water Scanlon, Culligan Water St. Cloud, Culligan Water Wadena, Kaski Inc., McKay's Company, and Traut Companies. Additional contractors are still being added, so please check the contract release for updates.

These contracts will provide various water treatment systems on an as needed basis to Minnesota State Agencies and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) Members. Must Use Contract Release Reminder - Contract Release P-707(5): Printed Envelopes: Plain, Window, and Kraft for State Agencies and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) Members

Contracts were recently awarded to: Heinrich Envelope Corporation, Lineage Mailing Services LLC, and Seachange Printing & Marketing Services LLC. This is a must-use contract for all Minnesota State

Agencies when purchasing printed envelopes unless an exception is approved in writing by the OSP contract manager.

These contracts will provide printed envelopes, plain, window and kraft on an as needed basis to Minnesota State Agencies and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) members. Update Reminder: Contract Release S-919(5) Service: Pest Control - Statewide

Guardian Pest Solutions, Inc. was recently acquired by Ecolab Pest Elimination. An assignment agreement has been fully executed to assign S-919(5) Service: Pest Control - Statewide from Guardian Pest Solutions, Inc. (contract #195115) to Ecolab Pest Elimination (contract #290774), effective July 1, 2026. If you receive an email from Ecolab offering an online portal or requesting that you set up autopay, please disregard. State agencies will continue to process purchase orders and payments through SWIFT.

Additionally, this contract has been extended through August 31, 2026. A solicitation has been posted, and it is anticipated that a new contract award(s) will be in place September 1, 2026. Reminder: Annual Budget and Accounting Instructions Posted

The [Annual Budget and Accounting Instructions - Document 1](#) has been posted to the SWIFT [Budget and Accounting Instructions](#) page. You can find this document under Establishing Budget Fiscal Year 2027 Budgets and Closing Fiscal Year 2026. The PO Hard Close job will run the weekend of August 14.

Statewide Systems Maintenance: August 27 – August 31

To keep our statewide systems current, Minnesota Management and Budget, the Department of Administration, and Minnesota IT Services are upgrading the technology that supports all statewide applications. As part of this work, the systems will be updated to the latest version of PeopleTools, the technology that runs PeopleSoft applications. The systems are also being moved to Oracle Cloud Infrastructure (OCI), which is expected to improve processing speed and overall system performance.

The launch date for this project is Monday, August 31, 2026. All statewide systems will be unavailable due to the system-wide upgrade beginning tonight, **Thursday, August 27, 2026, starting at 4:30 p.m., through Monday, August 31 at 6 a.m.** Please plan around this time to minimize the interruption of critical business functions. We apologize for the inconvenience.

Important note for Buyers in SWIFT: Please ensure that your events are not scheduled to start or end during this time as the Supplier Portal will be unavailable.

Note for Daily Interface Uploads: The daily interfaces will only be loaded up until Thursday evening, 8/27/26, at 6:00 PM. They will resume loading SWIFT on Monday morning, 8/31/2026, at 8:00 AM. All files sent in between these dates will sit in pending status on the mainframe FTP site. Agencies that send files with static filenames will need to be mindful of overwriting files that they have already sent to the mainframe FTP site but that haven't been loaded between these dates due to the upgrade.

Users must clear their internet browsing history and cache before they log into these systems on Monday, August 31.

Manual Solicitation and Single Source Postings

Agency buyers and members of the state's Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) program can use a [Solicitation Posting Form](#) in the Secure Area of OSP's website (login required). This is useful if you want to make a manual announcement for a solicitation that was not initiated in SWIFT or for Single Source Postings. For example, if your city wants to invite responses to a solicitation, it can use the form to describe the purchase and tell vendors how to receive the solicitation documents. Or, state agencies can post a Single Source Posting using the form. Those solicitations/postings appear on the state's pages for [Goods and Services Solicitation Postings](#) or [Professional and Technical Solicitation Postings](#).

To use the form, enter values into every field marked with an asterisk, and then use the other optional fields that are pertinent. For example, Shipping Information can be provided but is not required. For the field Contract Available to, state agencies can pull from the drop down list or enter Other; CPV members should use Other, then enter the name of their entity in the space below. Use the Description of Work field to put in a short description of your solicitation or the text of your single source notice; the text will appear on the website. Some simple formatting is available.

If you are posting about a P/T services contract, you are asked to provide an estimate of the value. Location of Work is an optional field, which can indicate whether you intend the work to be done at the vendor's location or alternatively at your own entity's location.

Most of us will skip the areas labeled: SWIFT Import Fields, Automated Fields, and Add Solicitation PDF or Addendum. Those areas are for a special process used by a limited team in OSP.

If you know the NAICS code(s) or UNSPSC code(s) associated with your purchase, you can enter up to seven in the fields provided.

Please skip the Addendum Form fields and settings along with the Bonfire Integration Data area, as those are for a special process used by a limited team within OSP.

Unfortunately, there is NO preview button, so it is recommended that you look back over your entry before you click the SAVE button. To see how your post might look before posting, you can view other live posts as examples on the state's posting pages, linked above. Once you click the SAVE button, the posting will go live almost instantly. Monthly SWIFT Reminder: Late Payments on Purchasing Card Statements

US Bank charges late fees on past due purchasing card (PCard) accounts. Agencies are invoiced in the amount of up to one percent (1%) per month on the amount overdue, or a minimum of \$2. Late fees are included on your monthly statement from US Bank and available to view in SWIFT. However, the Late Payment transaction cannot be reconciled the same way other transactions are reconciled.

To pay a late fee associated with a PCard statement, agencies must manually add this fee to their monthly PCard voucher by adding a line and entering the information. Make sure to enter Late Payment Charge in the **Description** field. In the **Account** field use Expense code 430008 (Interest Pd To Vend Late Pymt). After the line has been added, provide the voucher number to [SWIFT Help Desk](#) to have the transaction remove from the PCard pages.

As a reminder, pay PCard statements on time to avoid potential late fees, take advantage of available rebates, and avoid potential violations of Minn. Stat. §16A. Purchasing Policy 1b requires that Purchasing Card Coordinators use Access Online to review statements and monitor account activity.

FAQ: When is a State agency required to complete a Service Certification Form?

A Service Certification Form is required for single procurements over \$5,000 *for general services* and for procurements for the same services that go over \$5,00 cumulatively *in a fiscal year*.
