- Barnabas 22 by Mary Corwin / Room 318 update

- Barnabas 22 was previously scheduled for the approved 3rd Floor Exhibit Gallery roster, then removed due to artist's health issues; artist is now interested in continuing with the exhibit
- With the gallery rescheduled for the remainder of other approved exhibits, it is recommended that the Public Business Center (Room 318) be utilized for Corwin's work
  - Current exhibit is a student art work that focuses on water quality
- Option to discuss future programming of this room (or other CAEAC programmable spaces) in concert with capacity
  - Raney and Woods noted there is a constraint of time and financial resources prohibitive to expanding beyond the 3rd Floor Exhibit Gallery -Corwin's exhibit is an exception to accommodate the previous approval and present circumstances

    - Motion was voted on by roll call; motion passed unanimously
- Statute also permits the Committee to establish other officers as it deems necessary; Committee discussed the benefits of establishing Vice Chair and Past Chair officers; committee was favorable
  - Interim Chair Woods requested a motion to establish a Vice Chair and Past Chair to the CAEAC's officer positions
    - Motion: To establish Vice Chair and Past Chair as two new officer roles for the Capitol Art Exhibit Advisory Committee
    - Motion: Ghei, second: Owen
    - Motion was voted on by roll call; motion passed unanimously
  - Vice Chair discussion
    - Interim Chair Woods gauged interest the newly established Vice Chair position, citing Colin Nelson-Dusek as a potential candidate
    - Jones suggested that Nelson-Dusek write a statement of interest, to be submitted retroactively
    - Motion: To elect Colin Nelson-Dusek as Vice Chair of the Capitol Art Exhibit Advisory Committee
