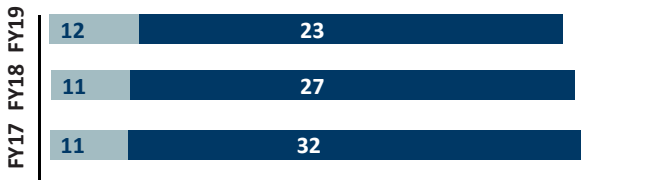

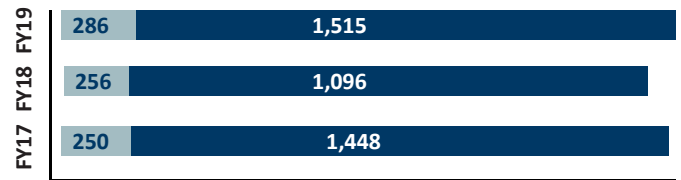

What We Do

Statutory Duties

- Assist the Commissioner of Administration in issuing data practices and open meeting advisory opinions.
- Assist the Commissioner with requests for temporary classification of government data and approving requests for new uses of government data
- Manage appeals of challenges to the accuracy or completeness of government data

Education

- Educate over 3,900 partners each year by providing technical assistance, interactive workshops, and other training on data practices and open meetings
- Train statewide entities with a high need to learn about data practices and open meeting laws
- Provide free presentations, videos, and live webinars on specific data practices topical areas to government entities and members of the public
- Prepare and provide informational materials for government and the public



Legislative Assistance

- Assist partners in drafting and tracking legislation
- Provide subject matter expertise on data practices and open meetings issues at the Legislature
