

HISTORIC CONTEXT: EARLY AGRICULTURE AND RIVER SETTLEMENT

Temporal Limits

1840-1870

The overall temporal limits for this context range from 1840, which is the date of the first farm near Afton (cited in Jarchow (1949)), to 1870, when it is judged that the agricultural area of the state is penetrated by a rail network connected to the national rail network, based on the 1870 rail network map in Rails to the North Star.

Context Narrative

Southern Minnesota was the setting for the early development of one of Minnesota's prime industries, agriculture. The 1837 Treaty with the Ojibwa opened the lands east of the Mississippi River for settlement. Treaties with the Dakota in 1851 and 1855 allowed settlement by Euro-Americans in certain areas west of the Mississippi. The Pre-emption Act of 1854, and the Homestead Act of 1862, all fostered the influx of settlers from the eastern states and Europe who hoped to acquire their own piece of cheap, fertile land. Speculators and settlers came by the steamboat-load following the major rivers and their tributaries -- the Minnesota and Mississippi Rivers.

The establishment of the Minnesota Territory in 1849 and statehood in 1858, the Panic of 1857, and the U.S.-Dakota War of 1862 all affected the flow and ebb of settlement.

Agriculture in this period was primarily subsistence level farming, although farmers began growing wheat as a cash crop.

Individual speculators, townsite companies, and groups with a particular ethnic or social homogeneity quickly developed townsites. Towns focused on rivers as sources of transportation and water power. More highly-planned townsites often had linear town-plats oriented to the river. Many of the towns became centers for agricultural product processing facilities, such as flour and sorghum mills and breweries, typically small operations that catered to a local market. Loosely organized rural communities were often centered on a country store or a church, and sometimes represented a concentration of ethnic settlement.
