CENSUS DAY is April 1, 2020

YOUR participation in the 2020 Census is important!

Data from the Census is key to:

- **Funding for federal programs:** Medicaid/Medical Assistance (MA), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), State Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP), and more!

- **Funding for Civil Rights and Advocacy programs**

- **Funding for education** (including special education) and student loans

- The **number of congressional** districts in Minnesota

US Census Bureau identifies people with disabilities a *hard-to-count* population. Undercounting affects federal funding and elected representation.

Participation in the Census is safe and *confidential!* Strict laws keep your information private. Information is *not* shared with other government agencies.

The Census is now available online and translated into 59 languages - including American Sign Language (ASL)!

Most households start receiving Census information in the US mail in March 2020 with instructions to complete the Census online.
