On 12-15-10 I received a call of a domestic from the address of 9148 White Oaks Trail. The caller, Lisa Marie Kelly - dob: 10-4-60, was calling, stating that she would be waiting in the area in a tan mini van, and wanted an officer to go to the house with her because she was afraid of her husband.

Officer Schneider and I had just cleared a domestic call at this address, that the same caller, Lisa had called in. At that time she was concerned about the safety of her son. The son, Ryan, had been arguing with his father, Ronald Lee Kelly - dob: 8-23-54. Reference case #10011845. At that time officer Schneider and I were comfortable leaving both parties in the home. Neither claimed that things had gotten physical and no crime had been committed. The two of them were just not getting along at this time and had been arguing. Things had deescalated by the time we arrived. Now Lisa was calling again, stating that she wanted an officer to accompany her because she was afraid of her husband, now that she has called the police on him.

I arrived and spoke with Lisa initially, and she explained to me that she was just afraid of how he was going to react and she is afraid of him.

I did accompany her to the home, along with officer Smith. We did go inside the house and she immediately started yelling at her husband, Ronald, that he needed help and should seek help for that. I stopped Lisa while she was speaking and had to raise my voice to get her to stop. She kept talking over me. I told her that we were there specifically just so she could get some things and to make sure everybody stayed calm, and that she needed to get her things and leave, if that's what she wished to do. I also told her that we were not there to get involved in a domestic dispute. Lisa then went upstairs and retrieved some of her belongings.

Ronald and the son, Ryan Howard Kelly - dob: 1-31-94, stated that they had been talking and having a good conversation since officer Schneider and I had left a short time earlier. Ryan stated that he wanted to stay home and was very comfortable staying home. He was not in fear of his father.

Lisa came down after a few minutes and had a bag of her belongings with her. She attempted to convince Ryan to go with her and said that she was nervous for Ryan, however, Ryan insisted that he wanted to stay. We then advised Lisa that this was not the time to be getting into this type of conversation, and advised her if she wished to leave the home, she should do that now.
