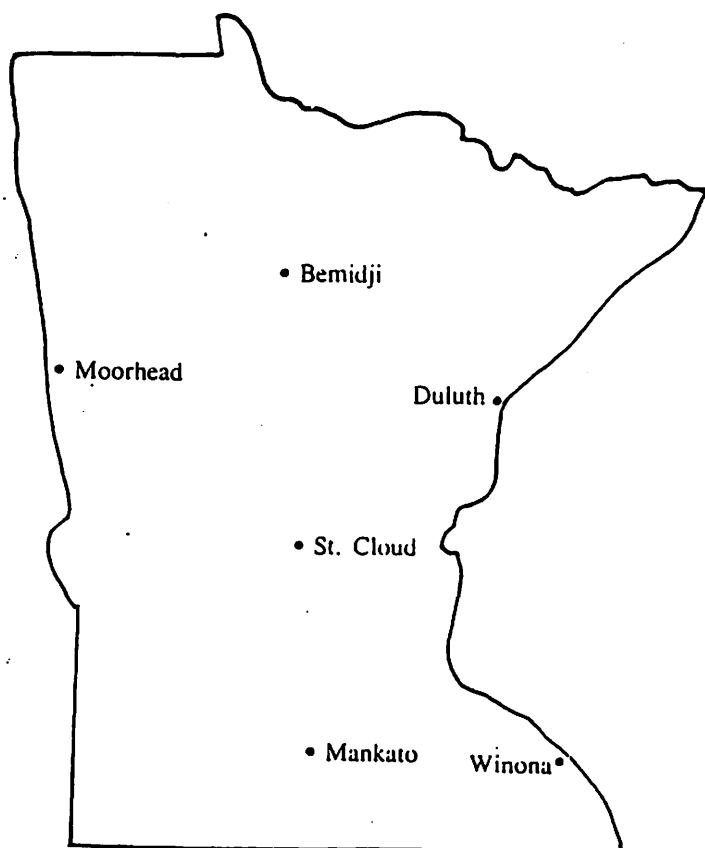

TREATMENT:

- * Sponsor a reuse study for Old Main at UMD -- cooperative agreement with PAM
- * Meet with State agencies to promote recognition of historic State Owned Buildings
- * Develop an agreement with Dept. of Administration for SHPO review of proposed changes to registered buildings
- * Work with State University system to encourage appropriate maintenance/management of registered buildings
- * Work with U of M to encourage appropriate maintenance/management of registered buildings on Duluth campus
