Fixed and Spot Price Fuel Program for Metro Area Participants

The State of Minnesota leads an annual fuel consortium that looks to provide a source for gasoline and diesel products at a fixed price for quantities that have been committed to by the program participants. The program also offers spot price rates for participants to use at their discretion. This program can be a useful budgeting tool for entities who want more stability and predictability in their annual fuel spends.

The State is currently gathering participant fuel quantities for the upcoming anticipated contract year (February 2026 – January 2027). The qualification requirements for potential participants include, but are not necessarily limited to, the following:

- Participant must by a Minnesota State Agency or Cooperative Purchasing Venture member.
- Participant must be located in the nine-county metropolitan area (Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Scott, Sherburn, Ramsey, Wright, and Washington).
- Participant must be able to take fuel deliveries of at least 500 gallon per delivery.
- Participant must take 100 percent of their committed monthly amount at the contracted fixed price.

Contract Release F-424(5): Freight and Small Package Delivery Services

A new Contract has been awarded to Spee Dee Delivery Service, Inc. which is effective November 1, 2025. The Contractor will provide intrastate and interstate zone-based small ground package pickup and delivery solutions within the State of Minnesota and the surrounding border States on an as needed basis for State Agencies and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) members. As detailed within the General Shipping Additional Charges and Rate Charges (page 6) of the Price Schedule, the maximum weight per package is 150 pounds. Oversize fees may apply for heavier packages. Reminder: Contract Releases C-871(5) and C-1046(5) Computer Equipment, Accessories, and Related Services – Plantronics/Poly Headsets Now Available!

Are you in need of headsets or other Voice over Internet Protocol phone equipment? Plantronics/Poly products are now available through HP, Inc., so resellers and contractors under Contract Releases C-871(5) and C-1046(5) can quote them. Since these products may be susceptible to tariffs and other price fluctuations, seeking multiple quotes can help protect you from higher costs should one reseller or contractor have them in stock while others may be shipping them in specifically for your purchase.

This is a great time to make use of that "bcc" function on emails and get multiple quotes from multiple vendors by sending the original email to yourself, then bcc'ing the companies you are seeking quotes from. Please bear in mind that reducing the time between receiving your quote and placing your order can help ensure you don't receive any unexpected price increases.

Reminder: SWIFT Purchase Order 'Standard Terms and Conditions' Update – September 1, 2025

Please note that the Standard Terms and Conditions on purchase orders has been updated. The updated language became effective in SWIFT and appeared on purchase orders as of September 1, 2025.

If you view the printable version of a purchase order, Standard Terms and Conditions display at the bottom. Item 8 includes information specific to debarment. The update also includes language specific to certain contract terms not allowed per Minnesota law, Minn. Stat. § 16C.05, subd. 8.


Monthly SWIFT Reminder - Late Payments on Purchasing Card Statements

US Bank charges late fees on past due purchasing card (PCard) accounts. Agencies are invoiced in the amount of up to one percent (1%) per month on the amount overdue, or a minimum of \$2. Late fees are included on your monthly statement from US Bank and available to view in SWIFT.

However, the Late Payment transaction cannot be reconciled the same way other transactions are reconciled.

To pay a late fee associated with a PCard statement, agencies must manually add this fee to their monthly PCard voucher by adding a line and entering the information.

Make sure to enter Late Payment Charge in the Description field. In the Account field use Expense code 430008 (Interest Pd To Vend Late Pymt). After the line has been added, provide the voucher number to Angie Brandt, and she will remove the transaction from the PCard pages.



As a reminder, pay PCard statements on time to avoid potential late fees, take advantage of available rebates, and avoid potential violations of Minn. Stat. §16A. Purchasing Policy 1b requires that Purchasing Card Coordinators use Access Online to review statements and monitor account activity.

If you create a purchase order impacted by a tariff, record the tariff on a separate line and use "78141503" as the **Category Code**. These purchases should be taxed according to the Minnesota Department of Revenue's guidance. View the <u>Sales Price</u> web page for more information.
