

FAQ for Request for Proposals Competitive Public Radio – 4th Release

- 1) If an applicant received a grant from the 3rd release of the Competitive Public Radio Grants will it play a factor in the decision to grant funds to the applicant if they apply for the 4th round of funding?

Answer: No, receiving a grant during the 3rd round of funding will not play a role in the decision to grant funds during the 4th round. However, funding cannot be used on any events or projects currently receiving Legacy funds.

- 2) Can a station submit more than one application/project proposal?

Answer: Yes, a station may submit more than one project proposal. The RFP states that the Department of Administration requests proposals to create and produce one radio project, but it does state that only one proposal will be accepted per applicant. Please note that each project proposal will be scored on a 100 point scale, and it is not guaranteed that both projects will be funded.
