



REQUIRED EDUCATION EVIDENCE

You are required to provide the Board evidence of meeting the education requirements in [MN Rules 1800.1500, Subp. 3](#) for licensure as a Landscape Architect.

(The table also notes the required years of experience based upon the education type. See [MN Rules 1800.1500 Subp. 4-6](#) or full details.)

Read below to determine what education proof **you must request be sent directly to the Board**, based on your education type:

Graduation from a landscape architecture master's degree program accredited by the Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB).	Submit your final, official transcript(s) in a sealed envelope from your educational institution(s). Send both undergraduate and graduate transcripts, if applicable/ necessary to document all required coursework. Transcript(s) may be email directly from the institution to the Board: aelslagid@state.mn.us or mailed directly from the institution(s) to the Board at the address above. All transcripts must be in English or accompanied by literal English translations completed by a certified translation service.	2
Graduation from a landscape architecture baccalaureate degree program accredited by LAAB or LAAC.		3
Graduation from a non-LAAB or non-LAAC accredited baccalaureate curriculum in landscape architecture; an NAAB-accredited degree architecture program; or an architectural, civil, or structural engineering degree program that is EAC-ABET accredited.		4
Graduation from any baccalaureate degree program from an accredited institution of higher education, or a two-year associates or certificate program in landscape architecture.		6
Graduation from a foreign college or university and you are applying under MN Rules 1800.1500, Subp. 3(A), item 3 or item 4 . Experience required depends upon item number (3 or 4) to which the education is equivalent.	You must obtain an evaluation or have an official copy of an existing evaluation sent to the Board. The evaluation must meet the Board's guidelines and must be sent directly from the evaluation service to the Board either by US mail or electronically (aelslagid@state.mn.us). FOREIGN EDUCATION: Applicants who have been educated outside the US must have their degree(s) evaluated. Education must meet the minimum number of soil science and closely related geoscience or environmental science areas as specified above.
