ORDER FOR REVOCATION

Kerry Gail Scott
Professional Engineer No. 57383 (Retired)

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 214.04, 270C.72, and 326.04, .06 (2024), the Board makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Kerry Gail Scott ("Respondent") Professional Engineer license, No. 57383 (Retired), holds a Retired Professional Engineer License issued by the Board.
2. On March 21, 2025, the Board received a Notice of License Revocation (attached as Exhibit 1) from the Minnesota Department of Revenue, which advised the Board of Respondent's outstanding delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest, and under Minn. Stat. § 270C.72 (2024), the Board must revoke Respondent's license to practice as a professional engineer in the State of Minnesota unless it receives a tax clearance from the Commissioner of Revenue.
3. The day the Board received the notification from the Department of Revenue, the Board notified Respondent by certified mail, sent to the address Respondent had on file with the Board on that date, of the potential revocation of his license.
4. The Board has not received a tax clearance from the Commissioner of Revenue.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 326.02 through 326.15 (2024)

to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, petition, or hold licenses to practice as professional engineers in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 214.10 to review complaints against professional engineers, investigate such complaints and initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 270C.72, subd. 1 (2024), the license of a professional engineer must be revoked if the licensee owes the State of Minnesota delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest, the Commissioner of Revenue so notifies the Board, and the Board does not receive a tax clearance from the Commissioner within thirty days of the notification.

ORDER

1. It is hereby ordered that Respondent's retired license to practice professional engineering in the State of Minnesota shall be REVOKED pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 270C.72, subd. 1 (2024) effective April 24, 2025.

2. It is further ordered that Respondent's license shall be reinstated by the Board after the Commissioner of Revenue or Respondent has submitted to the Board a tax clearance certificate from the Minnesota Department of Revenue indicating that Respondent does not owe the State of Minnesota any uncontested delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest.

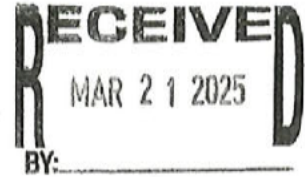

Pay the amount due. Contact the Minnesota Department of Revenue to get an updated amount.

How do I make a payment?

- **Pay by credit card or debit card.** Go to www.revenue.state.mn.us and type **make a payment** into the Search box. A third party processes these payments and charges a fee for this service.
- **Pay by ACH credit transfer through your financial institution.** Go to www.revenue.state.mn.us and type **ACH Credit** into the Search box.
- **Pay by check or money order.** Include the enclosed voucher. Write the Letter ID on the memo line, and mail to the address on the voucher. You can find the Letter ID in the top right corner of this letter.
- **Payment Agreements.** If you cannot pay this debt in full go to www.revenue.state.mn.us and type **payment agreement** into the Search box or call us at 651-556-3003 or 1-800-657-3909 (toll-free) to request one.

Note: You cannot enter into a payment agreement if your business has an active liquor license.
