**ORDER FOR REVOCATION
OF ARCHITECT'S LICENSE
AND CID CERTIFICATE**

License No. 23537 and CID No. C00991

1. The Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience and Interior Design ("Board") is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 326.02-326.15 (2006) to license, regulate, and discipline persons who apply for, or hold an architect's license or a Certified Interior Designer (CID) certificate in the State of Minnesota and is further authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §§ 326.111 and 214.10 (2006) to initiate appropriate disciplinary action.

2. Ronald L. Hernandez ("Respondent") has been and is now subject to the jurisdiction of the Board from which he holds an architect's license and a CID certificate.

3. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 270C.72, subd. 1 (2006), the Board must revoke a professional license or certificate if the license or certificate holder owes delinquent state taxes, penalties, or interest, and the Minnesota Commissioner of Revenue so notifies the Board.

4. On December 14, 2006, the Board received a Notice of License Revocation from the Minnesota Department of Revenue, which advised the Board that Respondent has an outstanding tax liability. Under Minn. Stat. § 270C.72 (2006), the Board must revoke the Respondent's license and CID certificate.

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's license and CID Certificate shall be REVOKED pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 270C.72, subd. 1 (2006.). During the period of revocation Respondent shall not offer to perform or perform any services in this state that require licensure as an architect or certification as a CID, including holding himself out to the public as an architect or CID.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that during the period of revocation, Respondent shall remove the designation of being a licensed architect or a certified CID from all Respondent's advertisements, business cards, business forms, and signage.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the revocation shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until the Board receives a Tax Clearance Certificate from the Minnesota Department of Revenue indicating that Respondent does not owe the State any uncontested delinquent taxes, penalties, or interest and has filed all required returns. If a Tax Clearance Certificate is received, the Board shall then issue an Order to rescind this revocation of Respondent's license and CID certificate.
