5) NEW BUSINESS

A) CLARB proposed model laws and rules

i) Unofficial redline comparing adopted (2017) and proposed (2022) CLARB model laws and rules. Discussed.

ii) Comparisons: CLARB proposals to Board rules. Discussions centered on the following concerns regarding the proposed CLARB model laws and rules changes:

a) reciprocal licensure language;

b) lack of credit given NAAB-accredited and EAC-ABET accredited degrees in majors related to architecture, structural, or civil engineering in the "alternative education path";

c) lack of any minimum *required* experience under a landscape architect; and

d) lack of any base education measurably above a high school degree.

The Chair referred to staff the creation of a document that codifies these concerns and can be presented to the full Board in March for discussion.

- B) Architect comity licensure issues
 - i) Statutes and rules regarding licensure classes shared by all Board professions
 - ii) NCARB Education Alternative
 - iii) Architect licensure rules

Language to establish the certification of the NCARB Education Alternative evaluation as “equal to” Board requirements as to education and experience in Board rules was discussed. The Chair referred to staff a review of Minnesota Rules to establish what range of prior-year rules would benefit from having the independent evaluation standard used to establish equivalency.
