## **STAY OF UNIT CLARIFIATION ORDER**

### **INTRODUCTION**

On April 19, 2012 the State of Minnesota, Bureau of Mediation Services (Bureau), issued a Unit Clarification Order (Order) in the above-entitled matter. The Order found that certain employees of the City of Coon Rapids, Minnesota (City) were public employees and should be included within the bargaining unit certified to Minnesota Teamsters Public and Law Enforcement Employees Union, Local No. 320, Minneapolis, Minnesota (Local 320). On April 30, 2012 the Bureau received a written request for reconsideration (Request) of the Order from the City. The City cited the following grounds for requesting reconsideration: no hearing was conducted as required by Minn. Stat. 179A.04, Minn. Stat. Sec 179A.12 and Minnesota Rules 5510.1910; the Order included named individuals rather than positions in a bargaining unit; and included individuals within a bargaining unit without consideration of the required factors outlined in Minn. Stat. Sec. 179A.09.

### **FINDINGS AND ORDER**

1. Based upon the timely receipt of the Request the Bureau will stay the Unit Clarification Order issued in this matter on April 19, 2012, until an investigation has been held and a final determination made.


